



Outside of Patras, west of Ities point and at the height of the Old National Road in municipality of Paralia, the mansions of the British (known as Egglezika) are situated. They were built based on neoclassical and foreign architecture styles.

They are remnants of the flourishing British community of Patras of the 19th century. Great courtyards and majestic buildings seem to have come from previous eras. Also the foundations of the wooden docks - platforms are also found there, which were used for boarding-disembarking from the sea taxis, which made the voyage Beach - Patras. Paralia municipality intends to rebuild the docks and to revive maritime tours with small crafts.
